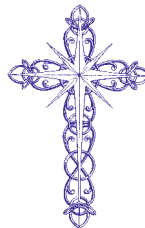

Welcome...

Welcome to the Peterborough Victoria Northumberland and Clarington Catholic District School Board's 2010 Secondary Summer School.

Summer School helps students start the next grade at the head of the class! Summer School reviews the past year, teaches new material for the year ahead, and provides computers, and hands-on activities.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Secondary Summer School will offer 4 types of courses:

1. **FULL CREDIT** course for 4 weeks in length (20 days).
2. **Grade 11-12 UPGRADING CREDIT COURSES** - course for 2 weeks in length (10 days). Upgrading refers to classes students have completed within the current school year.
3. **Grade 9-10 CREDIT RECOVERY** - course for 2 weeks in length (10 days). Credit Recovery refers to courses students have failed. Students must be referred for this program by the Student Success Team at their home school. The Credit Recovery course will be embedded in a LITERACY or NUMERACY REMEDIATION program.
4. **TRANSFER** courses provide eligibility to meet a prerequisite course.

Note: Students cannot be guaranteed which session courses are offered.

REGISTRATION BEGINS THURSDAY, APRIL 15, 2010

Registration must be completed online at <http://www.pvnccdsb.on.ca/schools/summer-school.asp>

Note: Students will be notified by email or by phone June 30, regarding their acceptance and session placement. Notification prior to this date is not possible, the master schedule is created after all registrations have been received.

Registration deadline is Monday, June 28, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. Please note that this includes submitting transcript and report cards for students NOT in PVNCCDSB.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

ATTENDANCE

- ★ If a student is late four (4) times by more than 15 minutes, it will count as one (1) day absent unless contact is made with the Principal of Summer School.
- ★ A student will be removed from, and fail to receive an evaluation, for any course in which she/he has been absent for any reason for more than four (4) days in a full credit program at Summer School; more than two (2) days for a 2 week session.

LUNCH

- ★ Students are expected to bring a lunch, snacks, and drinks to summer school.

MATERIALS

- ★ On the first day of class a \$25 deposit must be submitted for resources which will be refunded at the end of the program. Cheques can be made out to PVNC. All supplies and textbooks are loaned to students for the duration of Summer School only. The deposit will only be cashed if resources are lost or damaged, and the student will be billed for the remaining cost.

DRESS CODE

- ★ Students are expected to dress for summer learning. If a student is inappropriately dressed they will be sent home to get changed. Uniforms are not required.
Note: Each school site is air conditioned.

IS BUS TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED?

- ★ Rural transportation will be available from local pick-up points. Students will receive this information by contacting Student Transportation Services of Central Ontario (STSCO) at (705) 748-5500, Toll Free 1-800-757-0307 or visit the web site at www.stsco.ca.

Note: Since public transit is available within each of the host school's urban areas (i.e. City of Peterborough, Bowmanville and Cobourg) transportation is not provided to students residing in those areas and is the family's responsibility.

REGISTRATION DOCUMENTATION

- ★ **Note: If you are a student NOT from PVNCCDSB, after registering online, you must send a copy of your transcript, and IEP (if applicable), by fax to (705) 748-6639.**
- ★ **All summer school registration forms will be sent to your Guidance Office to validate course selection.**

EXAMS AND FINAL SUMMER SCHOOL REPORTS

- ★ Credit Recovery, Transfer and Upgrading Courses – Exams are written:
Session #1 on Friday, July 16, 2010
Session #2 on Friday, July 30, 2010
Exams will NOT be written at any other time.
- ★ Full Credit Courses - Exams are written on Friday, July 30, 2010. Exams will NOT be written at any other time.
- ★ Midterm report cards for Full Credit courses will be available by Tuesday, July 20, 2010.
- ★ Full Disclosure - Students have until Wednesday, July 21, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. to withdraw from a full credit course, and by 9:00 a.m. on the sixth (6th) day of classes for credit recovery, transfer and upgrading courses. After this date/time senior credit course attempts will be disclosed on the student's transcript.
- ★ Final reports for Summer School will be mailed in August.
- ★ Copies of report cards will be sent to home schools.
