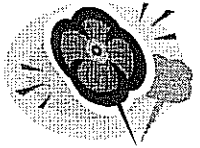

















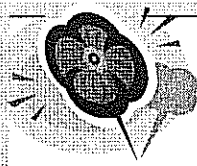

**November 26/27**—Advent Begins and the New Text begins during Masses.

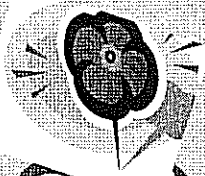
**November 20**— Confirmation Registration Deadline
