QUESTIONS TO ASK

Ask yourself the following questions before:

- What programs or courses interest me?
- Which subject(s) am I good at?
- How many years do I plan to be in college?
- How will I pay for college?
- How early should I start saving for college?
- Is living at home a possibility/preference?
- Can I afford to live away from home?
- Do I want to live away from home?
- Is the look and feel of the campus I choose important to me?

Admission Requirements:

- What courses are required in order to be admitted into the programs that interest me?
- Are there additional requirements for admission to the program I am interested in?

Program:

- Does your college have the program that interests me?
- What is the difference between a diploma and an advanced diploma?
- Will this program allow me to transfer to a university?
- Where can I get more information about a particular program?

Finances:

- What are the costs involved in attending your college for one year? (Tuition)
- Do you award scholarships automatically or do I need to apply?
- What are the criteria for your scholarships and when are the amounts determined?

Lifestyle:

- How do I apply for residence?
- Is residence guaranteed?
- What varsity sports are available?
- Can I still play sports if I'm not on a varsity team?
- Are there campus support services offered especially for new students?
- What are the first-year class sizes like at your college?
- Do class sizes vary according to the program I choose?
- Will there be special events throughout the year that will be geared towards the first-year students who will be admitted in 2009?

- Can I make arrangements to see a specialized area of the college that I hope to pursue?
- Are you offering any special open houses during the fall?
